<u>Program</u>

On Friday, May 31, the traditional Meet & Greet will take place in Hotel Marivaux from 13h30 on.

About one hour later all participants and partners are taken by bus to the Royal Library, where the participants will enjoy a special exhibition on the Orders and Decorations of H.M. Queen Elisabeth, spouse of H.M. King Albert I, and the phaleristic highlights from the Royal Library's proper Coins and Medal Cabinet.

Partners will visit the Royal Library for the temporary exposition on the Belgian painter James Ensor.



At 19h00 we are all expected for dinner at the *Le Roy d'Espagne* restaurant on the Brussels *Grand' Place*.

Saturday June 1:

Participants stay in the hotel for the presentations, partners walk to the Choco-Story Museum for a visit to the museum and a chocolate workshop.

Lunch will be taken together at the hotel.

In the afternoon a guided tour will take us all through the Old Town of Brussels.
